Volunteer Role Title:	Circles Host (Veterans)
Department Name:	Friendship Service Circles
Location:	Home-based
Job Title of volunteer supervisor(s):	Friendship Coordinator, Friendship Manager
Time Commitment:	1-2 hours per week at the same time each week (with some flexibility for cover) over a 6 month minimum period.
Background	The Circles service enables socially isolated older members of the community to enjoy camaraderie with others in regular and facilitated telephone group calls.
Purpose of the role:	Facilitation of the circle and involve members in group discussions and conversations.
Main Tasks Include:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Logging into Age Scotland IT systems • Welcome members to the circle • Facilitate group discussions and ensuring all members have a chance to participate. • Reporting any concerns or issues with the circles to Supervisor. • Where possible, giving the Supervisor advanced notice of any absence. • From time to time, providing feedback and completing further training as necessary to support you and your volunteering role.
Required Qualities & Experience:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creativity for developing engaging resources in response to circle participant's interests. • Agreeing and complying with Age Scotland's policies and procedures. • An understanding of and commitment to equal opportunities.
